PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- This project will construct a new Science and Technology Building on the UNT main campus. The selected firm will be required to provide preconstruction and construction services for a new Science & Technology Building of approximately 105,000 GSF.
- This building will feature flexible wet and dry open research laboratories for interdisciplinary research, a vivarium, core equipment space, BSL-3 Lab space (to be designed and constructed to meet BSL-3 standards, however, will not be commissioned until a later date), potential clinical space, meeting rooms, collaborative spaces, and other work areas.
- Construction to be substantially complete no later than April 2026.



SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS/CRITERION

- Proposed fees.
- Ability to obtain bond for project- Letter from Bonding Company
- Respondent & proposed team's experience, capability to perform pre-construction services, & construction management services.
- Project execution plan & technical competence as a construction manager.
- Utilization of cost estimating & construction cost control plan insuring budget is not exceeded.
- Utilization of construction scheduling throughout design & construction phases.
- Capability to perform a quality control process during entire project duration.
- Job site safety record.



SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS/CRITERION – cont'd

- HUB Sub-contracting policies & approach – Criterion G.
(Please be sure to read this criteria and address in your response. As noted in this section, Item 1, is asking your company to meet or exceed the UNT System's **HUB goal of 30% for building construction**.)
- Understanding and the ability to partner with Owner to support the community, mission & vision of campus and the project.

What is a Historically Underutilized Business (HUB)?

It is at least 51% owned by an Asian Pacific American, Black American, Hispanic American, Native American, American woman and/or Service-Disabled Veteran, who reside in Texas and actively participate in the control, operations and management of the entity's affairs.



What is a HUB?

- It is certified by the State of Texas.
- It is a for-profit entity that has not exceeded the size standards prescribed by 34 TAC §20.23 and has its principal place of business in Texas.



State of Texas and UNT System HUB Utilization Goals

- ***Building Construction – 21.1%***
- Special Trade Construction – 32.9%
- Professional Services – 23.7%
- Other Services – 26%
- Commodities – 21.1%
