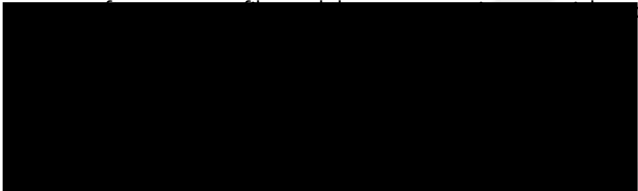

c) Cf. 1.1 Authorized Users:

e) Cf. 3.1 Annual License Fee

This is a three (3) year subscription term for Thieme Teaching Assistant Anatomy with 3% annual increases:

f) Cf. 3.1 Material Changes

An additional and separate License Agreement is needed if the Licensee intends to include Sites that are not part of this agreement.

g) Cf. 5.1 Termination of the License Agreement

h) Additional Agreement

In addition to the rights granted (cf. 1.2), Publisher hereby grants to the Authorized Users of the Licensee the following rights to copy, edit, export and print images, tables, or other content from the Licensed Work for non-commercial educational purposes use only.

The use of the Licensed Work is limited to:
 a) use with software such as MS PowerPoint.
 b) use for other teaching materials, provided that the number of handouts does not exceed 200 copies per presentation.
 c) posting a presentation and its accompanying materials onto a password-protected Intranet.

The usage of the material from the Licensed Work is subject to the following limitations:

- a) The Authorized Users may not post any of the images onto a public website without the expressed, written permission of the Publisher.
- b) Authorized Users are not permitted to sell or otherwise commercially use the content of the Licensed Works, whether these be the images collectly or individually, nor shall they be permitted to sell or commercially use a document or presentation which contains the images without express written permission of the Publisher.
